No Parole for Convicted Cop Killers Henry Robinson, Alvin Lewis and George DeCosta

On July 21, 1974, Fort Lauderdale Police Officer Ilyankoff was shot and killed at the Red Lobster restaurant on N. Federal Hwy. as he responded to an alarm interrupting a robbery in progress. Four subjects were arrested and convicted of Ofc. Ilyankoff's murder. Alvin Ford, Henry Robinson, Alvin Lewis and George DeCosta were all sentenced to LIFE in prison. Alvin Ford has since died on death row.

In August / September 2012, Robinson, Lewis and DeCosta will be granted a parole hearing to determine if and when they will be eligible for release. As a representative of the Ft. Lauderdale Police Department, Detective Shotwell will be speaking, along with Ofc. Ilyankoff's widow and a prosecutor from the State Attorney's Office, AGAINST parole believing that "life means life."
